Who We Are

The Canadian Federation of University Women (CFUW), a non-profit organization, promotes advancing the status of women, human rights, justice, peace, and the provision of quality public education.

The Brantford Club was formed in 1945 by a group of local women who were seeking opportunities for lively and stimulating discussion. Over the years, the Club has hosted community events featuring well-known writers such as Paula Todd, Sally Armstrong, Mary Lou Finlay and Maureen Jennings; and has partnered with other organizations to offer All-Candidates Meetings and Campaign Schools.

CFUW (www.cfuw.org) has 9,000 members in 110 Clubs across Canada, and is the largest of 61 affiliates around the world that comprise the International Federation of University Women (www.ifuw.org). CFUW advises the Canadian Government on education, the status of women, human rights, justice, social, and environmental issues, and consults at the UN and UNESCO.

CFUW Brantford was instrumental in establishing the Teen Esteem Program, and in 1997 wrote and produced the book, *Significant Lives: Profiles of Brant County Women*, which highlighted exceptional local women from the 1800's to the 1990's. Internationally, it has participated in *Breaking Bread*, a fund-raiser for educating girls in Afghanistan. CFUW Brantford partners with Nova Vita, a local domestic violence prevention service, on International Women's Day activities. The Club also awards scholarships annually to women pursuing post-secondary education.
